



Update – Japanese Earthquake

Sydney, 15 March 2011

Aristocrat Leisure Limited (ASX: ALL) today announced there have been no reports to date of serious injury to any Aristocrat employees in the aftermath of the Japanese earthquake. The Group's immediate priority following the earthquake was to confirm the safety of all staff in the region. The Group's Tokyo office remains operational.

Management is working closely with customers, agents and distributors throughout the region to assess the full impact of the earthquake on their facilities and operations.

At this early stage management do not consider there will be a significant impact on the Group's operations in Japan resulting from this tragedy but will continue to monitor the situation. The Group will keep the market updated if there are any material changes to this assessment.

Aristocrat's CEO and Managing Director Jamie Odell said our thoughts are very much with our staff, partners and all the people of Japan during this difficult time.
